

The 2016 Christmas In The Park Festival will be on Saturday, November 26, 2016 from 11:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m. The fireworks and lighting of the park will take place around 6:00 p.m. and this year promises to be even better than last year (and last year was fabulous). The festival takes place at the City of Jasper's Sandy Creek Park on Marvin Hancock Drive close to our downtown area. The creek is surrounded by a walking path and the fireworks take place over the creek itself.

Musical entertainment will be provided during the day with local and professional talent. The two trains will be running around the park except for the areas that are off-limit due to the fireworks setup. We were filled with capacity for last year regarding vendor spaces, and we are hoping to rearrange in order to accommodate a few more. Requests are coming in daily for a vendor spot. The majority of the vendors will be set-up on Marvin Hancock Drive itself. There are a few spots inside the park itself. Those will be filled with special request on a first come first served basis.

Our local school district is once again providing transportation from downtown parking areas to the street entrance where patrons can walk or take the City's trolley car transportation to the park entrance itself.
